### **MEETING MINUTES**

A public meeting to discuss the status of the Catahoula Formation Hydrostratigraphic and Model Study by the Lone Star Groundwater Conservation District (LSGCD) was held Wednesday, August 24, 2011, at 1:30 p.m., in the San Jacinto room of the Lone Star Convention Center, located at 9055 Airport Road, Conroe, Texas.

In attendance at said meeting were: Kathy Turner Jones, General Manager; Paul R. Nelson, Assistant General Manager; LSGCD Director John D. Bleyl; LSGCD Director Reed Eichelberger; LSGCD Director Roy McCoy; LSGCD Director Scott Weisinger; Mark Lowry, District Consultant; John Seifert, LBG-Guyton; Steve Young, INTERA; District staff; and members of the public *(see Attachment "A" for a list of attendees)*.

Paul Nelson began by welcoming the public and recognized Kathy Turner Jones, General Manager; Luine Hancock, Legislative Liaison for Senator Robert Nichols; and Lone Star Groundwater Conservation District Board members in attendance. Ms. Jones gave a brief background on the study and introduced the engineers responsible for the study, John Seifert, LBG-Guyton and Steve Young, INTERA.

Mr. Seifert and Mr. Young gave a presentation on the Catahoula formation study. They discussed the methods they are using in the study, the interim and provisional findings, and the anticipated next steps.

Following the presentation, Ms. Jones, Mr. Nelson, Mr. Seifert, and Mr. Young entertained questions from the audience relative to the study, the Catahoula, and Montgomery County's water supply in general, for a period of approximately twenty-five minutes before the meeting ended.

Mr. Nelson stated that the presentation would be made available on the LSGCD website, in PDF format, and thanked everyone for coming on behalf of himself, Ms. Kathy Jones, General Manager, and the LSGCD Board.
